Advanced Bionics does NOT promote playing in the water or swimming with your implant on. If you are near the water or sand, it is best to take precautions to keep the water or sand off the equipment. Here are some products that can safeguard that:

PSP

- Put the PSP in any of the various plastic bags/cases seen below and put inside of a hip pack.
- Many of these plastic bags/cases also have straps that you can wear around your neck.
- Most of the MP3 player cases have some sort of protection that if used with waterproof headphones, they are claiming that you can listen to your player underwater. While we are obviously not suggesting that people wear their SP underwater, this style of case may be a good option since there will be an outlet for their cable already.

Protecting the headpiece

- Take a plastic sandwich bag, cut off one of the corners, put the headpiece in it, secure the bottom with a twist tie.
- Put a small balloon around the headpiece.
